Catch, the popular seafood restaurant in the meatpacking district in New York City, is expanding with locations in Dubai, Los Angeles and Playa del Carmen, Mexico. Catch opened in April at the Fairmont Dubai in the center of town. The 200-seat space mimics the décor in New York of plush burgundy leather booths and copper and brick accents. The menu is also similar and includes items offered in New York like tuna tartare and wasabi on a crisp rice cake and scallop gnocchi with black truffle. A handful of dishes like the chile-rubbed whole roasted sea bass and kingfish tacos are unique to Dubai.

The other two locations — in the West Hollywood area of Los Angeles and at the Thompson hotel in Playa del Carmen — are scheduled to open within the next six months.
